Preserving Chatham Hall's Campus

Chatham Hall's beautiful campus is one of the School's most effective recruitment tools for prospective students, faculty, and staff. Its 362 acres of playing fields, roads, walking and riding trails, courtyards, and gardens are an inspiration to all members of the Chatham Hall family. The School's rural beauty and peace set the tone for school life. Chatham Hall's boarding facilities are among the best of its peer schools, and its teaching spaces are state-of-the-art.

Caring for and maintaining this extensive campus and physical plant are huge tasks, and the Chatham Hall staff regularly finds itself making tough choices about what projects can be taken on. Our endowment does not permit a sufficient annual plan for such priorities as faculty housing refurbishment, campus-wide painting and re-carpeting, vehicle replacement, and industrial appliance and equipment replacement. As a result, the School each year has a list of deferred maintenance and enhancement projects that cannot be funded out of the operating budget or through our modest endowment.

An Invitation to Give

Chatham Hall can no longer afford to neglect this important asset and invites your help in preserving its beautiful campus and facilities by endowing a preservation fund. Such a plan will assure the continuous care of our campus in the future, improving the quality of life for both students and faculty.
